

Accessibility

If you need help or cannot board a replacement bus, please contact PTV prior to travelling on **1800 800 007** to discuss your travel options or speak to our staff at the bus stop for alternative transport to be arranged at no cost.

Bikes and pets



Bicycles, dogs and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

In accordance with the *Victorian Fares & Ticketing Manual 2019*, bicycles (except folding bicycles), surfboards and dogs and other pets are not permitted to travel on buses, with the exception of guide dogs, hearing guide dogs, guide dogs in training, animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass and small animals if they are suitably contained.

Car park closures

Parts of station car parks will be impacted due to bus operations. Refer to ptv.vic.gov.au for more information.

Allow extra time

We estimate an additional 45-75 minutes will be added to most people's journey.

Travel times will vary depending on where you start and finish your trip, and whether you travel during peak or off-peak. We encourage you to plan ahead to avoid lengthy delays.

Rail, road and tram - January disruptions



Buses replace trains:

Cranbourne and Pakenham lines

Between Flinders Street and Westall from Wednesday 2 January to Sunday 13 January.

Frankston line

Between Flinders Street and Moorabbin from Wednesday 2 January to Sunday 13 January.

(Also, the following weekend between Mordialloc and Frankston from 8pm Friday 18 January to last service Sunday 20 January.)

Sandringham line

Between Flinders Street and Elsternwick from Wednesday 2 January to 4am Sunday 6 January.

Belgrave, Lilydale, Alamein and Glen Waverley lines

Between Flinders Street and Burnley from 1am Saturday 12 January to last service Sunday 13 January.



V/Line services

Coaches replace all Traralgon and Bairnsdale services for the entire journey from Wednesday 2 January until Sunday 13 January.



Route 75 tram works

Buses replace trams along Toorak Road between Camberwell Road and Warrigal Road from Thursday 3 January to 5am Saturday 12 January.

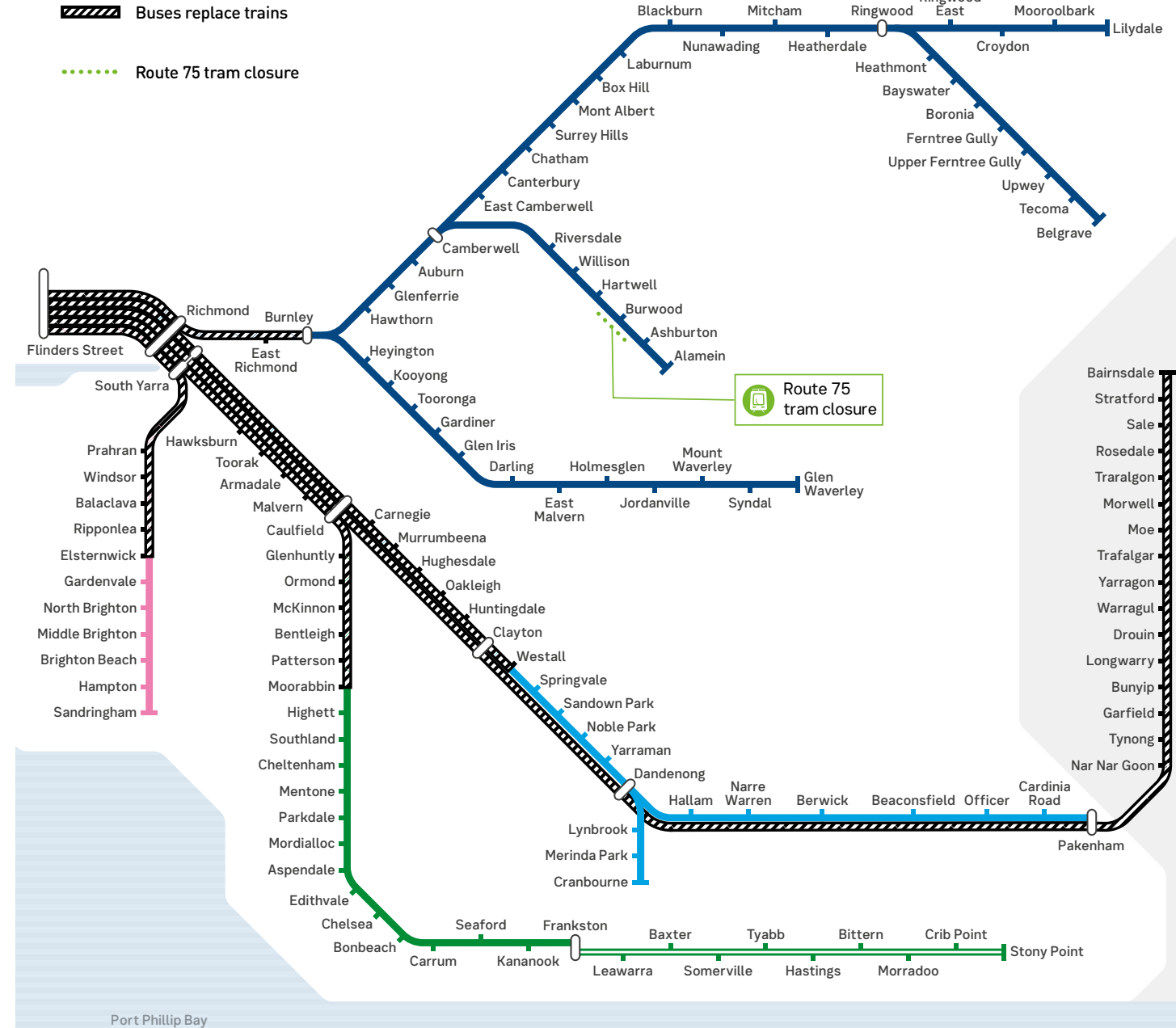


Yan Yean Road upgrade

What's happening in January?

Melbourne and Victoria are growing and, in order to keep people moving, we need to expand and modernise the transport network to move more people and make travel easier. This involves some disruption.

In January, a major Summer Construction Blitz will take place, affecting public transport and road users as we take advantage of school holiday periods when it is historically quieter.

- Works to improve rail infrastructure and construction of the eastern entrance to the Metro Tunnel will affect rail users.
- Yarra Trams has critical maintenance works along Toorak Road between Warrigal Road and Camberwell Road impacting Route 75.
- V/Line is taking the opportunity to do maintenance work on the Gippsland line when the Pakenham line is out of use.
- Major works to build a new intersection at Yan Yean, Aqueduct and Diamond Creek roads in Plenty will impact road users.

Before travelling, we recommend you plan ahead, allow more time for your journey and consider alternatives. Please be aware of more people using the roads, or an alternative line or route, if their usual journey is disrupted.

For stations between Flinders Street and Caulfield, take a Cranbourne and Pakenham line stopping all stations replacement bus from Federation Square.

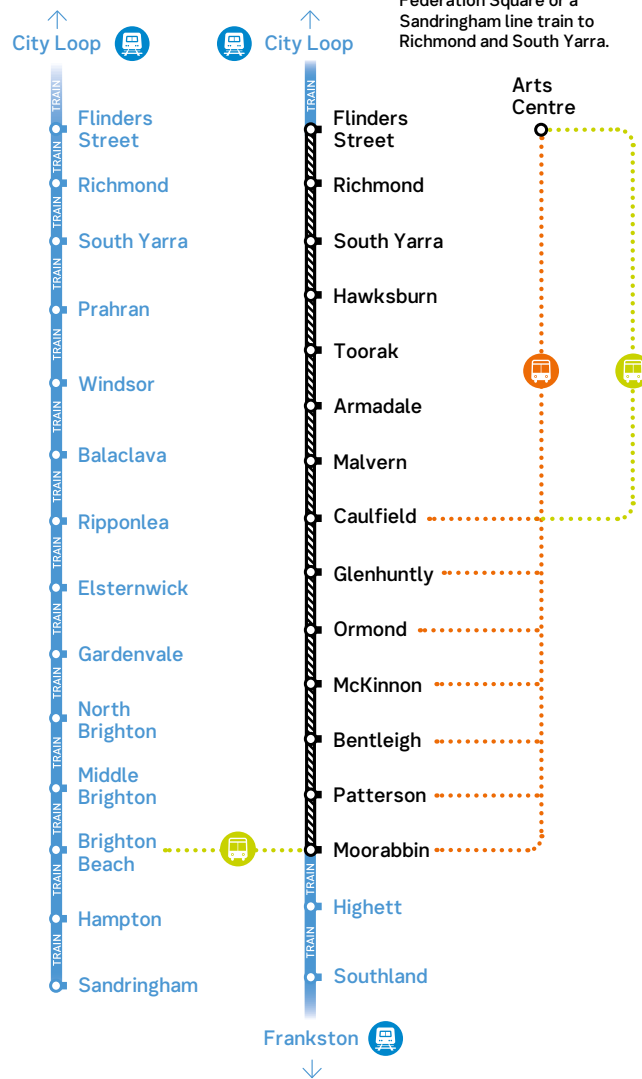


Stopping all stations

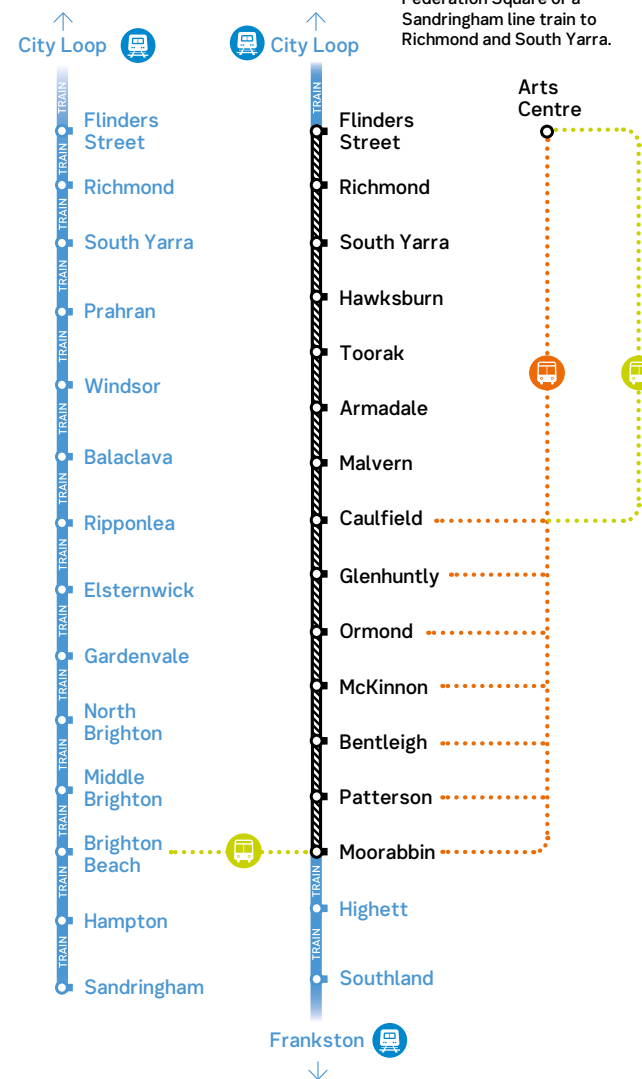
