

Public Transport Victoria, Regional Rail Link Authority and V/Line are working to improve your Geelong line train service.

New tracks between South Kensington and Southern Cross Station will separate V/Line and Metro trains to improve service reliability.

From **Sunday 22 December 2013:**

- > Most Geelong trains will use the new V/Line-only tracks
- > Most Geelong trains will use the new platforms 15 and 16 at Southern Cross Station
- > Geelong line trains will have a new timetable, with some trains departing earlier
- > **Geelong line trains will no longer stop at North Melbourne Station, however all Geelong line trains will connect with the metropolitan rail network at Footscray and Southern Cross stations.**

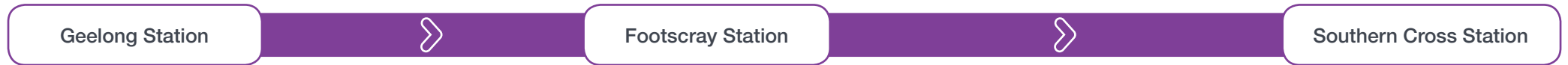

Plan your journey

From Geelong to Melbourne



Change at Footscray for:



Metro trains to North Melbourne where you can connect to the 401 bus to Parkville

Note: Same platform connection at Footscray Station

Change at Southern Cross for:



City Loop trains, departing frequently from platform 9



Flinders Street trains



Trams into the CBD

From Melbourne to Geelong



Getting to Southern Cross:



From the City catch a tram to Southern Cross to connect with your Geelong train.

Note: Before 1pm, City Loop trains are also an option to reach Southern Cross



From Flinders Street, catch a Metro train to Southern Cross to connect with your Geelong train.

Getting to Footscray:



From the City Loop, catch a Sunbury line Metro train to connect with your Geelong train at Footscray.



From the 401 bus, catch a Laverton, Werribee or Williamstown Metro train from North Melbourne for a same platform connection with your Geelong train at Footscray.
